# **Campaign Actions**

### 1) <u>Influence</u> others to take back the MN State House!

[Click the "MN Influence Handout" button at the top of our site.] Share (post, text, email) this 'handout' to anyone who has religious convictions or traditional values which have raised concerns with the direction the state has headed the last few years. Laws can be changed but a constitutional amendment is VERY hard to change.

### 2) Register on TrumpForce47.com

Then Sign up for a MN weekly Thursday Zoom Captains training event (or attend our 10/12 club meeting for in-person training!)
Registering enables campaign staff to provide you with a login and password on the campaign app after your training session so you can begin right away to contact voters at their door to survey them and also by phone to help chase votes in MN for TRUMP.

### 3) Download the Campaign SideKick App! Android / iOS

This app will allow you to fight for Trump as a Captain talking with voters in your neighborhood at their door and use the phone function to chase ballots to be cast early.

### 4) **Volunteer** to Fight for Election Integrity!

Sign up to help be a poll watcher or some other function to help secure our ballots as they are cast.

## **Voter Actions**

### 1) Order YOUR Absentee Ballot!

TRUMP has asked us to plan to vote early but you may vote and battle potential ballot shortages and/or long lines on Election Day. Please know that campaigns are investing volunteer time and \$\$\$'s to call voters to make sure they cast their absentee ballot so it saves campaign time and dollars if you vote early.

### 2) Review and research What's on Your Ballot!

Be sure to research non-partisan races like schoolboard, city councils, township boards and judges. See what school referendums are up for votes or other amendments are requested to be approved. Always great to discuss these with other RVAF members!

### 3) Plan WHEN and HOW you will Vote!

**In-Person, early voting** is preferred. Ideally, vote **ten to two days BEFORE Election Day** (**10/25 - 11/3**). Early voting locations will have ballots run through the tabulators on these dates. As a precaution, this time frame will not allow for potential nefarious actions to spin-up ballots to cancel your vote.
